



**College of Paramedics of Manitoba Process for Adoption of Bylaws**  
**at the Annual General Meeting – June 29, 2021**

The following process will be used to adopt the Bylaws of the College of Paramedics of Manitoba at the Annual General Meeting to be held virtually on June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

The practice of paramedicine regulation M.R. 103/2020 states *in section 9: the by-laws, standards of practice and code of ethics made by the transitional council that are in force on the day this regulation comes into force are deemed to be the college's by-laws, standards of practice and code of ethics made under the Act until they are amended or repealed under the Act.*

Since coming into force on December 1, 2020 Transitional Council of the College of Paramedics of Manitoba have identified the need to revise further language in the Bylaws. A copy of the most current Bylaws of the College of Paramedics of Manitoba that reflect further proposed changes from Transitional Council are being provided to registrants of the college with the notice of the AGM.

Proposed amendments to the CPMB Bylaws must be submitted in writing using the prescribed form and must be received by the College by May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2021 by 4:00 p.m. There will be no exceptions to this deadline.

The proposed amendments to the Bylaws in conjunction with the entire current Bylaws will be circulated back to registrants along with the final agenda for the AGM by May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

In order to manage the business item of adoption of the Bylaws as efficiently as possible in a vital forum only amendments to the bylaws proposed in advance of the meeting and in compliance with the submission deadline will be considered.
