



## PCP/ACP Exam Registration Information

### Exam Writing Timeline

The PCP and ACP entry to practice Exams are provided by the Canadian Organization of Paramedic Regulators (COPR) Please go to [www.copr.ca](http://www.copr.ca) for registration.

Candidates have (3) attempts to successfully complete (pass) the PCP/ACP Examination.

Candidates must register for and write their first exam attempt **within eight (8) months** of completing an approved (by CPMB) PCP or ACP Program.

Candidates must complete the entrance to practice exam process (successful completion of the exam or unsuccessful at 3 attempts) **within eighteen (18) months** of completing an PCP or ACP Program. (For information regarding further access to the COPR exam please see the Policy [here](#)).

### Eligibility

To be eligible to write the PCP or ACP exam, a candidate must successfully complete an PCP or ACP Program approved by the College of Paramedics of Manitoba.
