



Complaints Investigation Committee Decision

Voluntary Surrender – CPMB Registrant William Scott Lancaster

Background

On September 9, 2022, an employer report was received that raised concerns about the knowledge skills and judgment displayed by the registrant while providing care during an interfacility transfer.

The Registrar referred the complaint to the Complaints Investigation Committee (CIC). The CIC reviewed the employer report and appointed an investigator to investigate the case on November 22, 2022.

Decision

On April 19, 2023, the College of Paramedics of Manitoba, Complaints Investigation Committee reviewed the investigator's report. The Complaints Investigation Committee directed that in accordance with RHPA s102(1)(a) refer the matter, in whole, to the inquiry committee.

The registrant requested to have the matter be resolved by accepting their voluntary surrender of their certificate of practice. The registrant was agreeable to executing a Statement of Agreed Facts and voluntarily surrendering their license on that basis.

The registrant signed the Statement of Agreed Facts and voluntary surrender of their registration and certificate of practice on January 23, 2024.
