ORDER

Upon hearing the submissions of counsel for the parties, and upon hearing the evidence adduced by way of an Agreed Statement of Facts, and acknowledging the guilty plea entered by Mr. Woiden to the charges set out in the Notice of Inquiry dated March 16, 2023, the Panel hereby finds, pursuant to Section 124(2) of the *Act*, that Mr. Woiden has contravened the *College of Paramedics of Manitoba Code of Ethics* and the *College of Paramedics of Manitoba Standards of Practice for the Paramedic Profession* and that, by virtue of those contraventions, is guilty of professional misconduct.

The Panel, pursuant to subsection 126(1) and section 127 of the *Act*, hereby orders that:

- (a) Mr. Woiden be reprimanded;
- (b) Mr. Woiden be suspended for 8 days, on dates to be fixed in consultation with the WFPS and the Registrar of the College;
- (c) the Reasons for Decision of this Panel be published and made available to the public; and,
- (d) Mr. Woiden pay costs of \$5,000.00 to the College, on terms to be fixed in consultation with the Registrar of the College.
