All Council meetings are open to the public and the media except during “in camera” portions of meetings. The “in camera” sessions are used only when the subject matter is related to personnel, complaints, investigation and discipline proceedings or other highly confidential situations.

Meeting Details

Meetings begin at 9:00 a.m. and typically end around 4:30 p.m. Members of the public are invited to attend virtually via MS Teams. There are morning and afternoon rest breaks and a break for lunch.

Can I speak at a meeting?

Only Council members and certain staff are involved in Council discussions. Guests may not speak to issues or ask questions during the business session. Guests will receive an agenda of the meeting items.

Considerations During Council Meetings

Council meetings are held in a respectful, orderly environment with minimal distractions so the day can be productive.

- Please turn off cell phones. No video recordings are allowed.
- Please do not talk once the meeting has been called to order.
- Via a Teams meeting please indicate in the chat function the reason for leaving the meeting and whether you expect to re-join the meeting.

The Council sets policy and governs the College of Paramedics of Manitoba in the interest of the public. The Council is made up of two-thirds Paramedics and one-third public representatives.

The Council meets for a full day, four times per year in September, December, March and June and meeting dates are posted on our website.
