Kirk Seniuk Inquiry Panel Decision and Inquiry Panel Orders

The College of Paramedics of Manitoba protects the public interest by following the professional conduct processes described in *The Regulated Health Professions Act (RHPA)*.

The Inquiry Panel Decision and the Inquiry Panel Orders are published as required by the RHPA s. 129(1). The purpose of the publication is to demonstrate to the public that the College and its registrants take appropriate action on serious conduct matters.
