



## **Statement from the Registrar of the College of Paramedics of Manitoba**

### **Saru Chahal Inquiry Panel Decision and Inquiry Panel Orders**

The College of Paramedics of Manitoba fulfills its mandate to serve and protect the public interest by following the professional conduct processes described in *The Regulated Health Professions Act (RHPA)*.

The Inquiry Panel Decision and the Inquiry Panel Orders are published as required by the RHPA s. 129(1). The purpose of the publication is to demonstrate to the public that the College takes appropriate action on serious professional conduct matters.

This Decision and Order also serve as a reminder to College Registrants that they must always hold themselves accountable to their profession's Code of Ethics and the Standards of Practice for the Paramedic Profession. All registrants have a duty to ensure that the integrity and image of paramedicine and the public's trust in the profession is upheld.
